17Hundred90

Following the American Revolution and independence from England, the first free election of a mayor, city council and the formation of a Savannah city government occurred in 1790. Savannah was a small village with a few hundred frame buildings, sandy streets, horses and wagons, and a simple, yet prosperous life. Celebrating that heritage, the 17hundred90 Restaurant and Inn is one of Savannah's oldest restaurants and Inns offering fine dining and comfortable lodging.

The restaurant and Inn are housed in what were originally three separate residences. The western part of the building was built as a duplex between 1821 and 1823 by Steel White; the smaller eastern section was built by the Powers family in 1888. The ground level with its slate floor and soft brick walls are thought to date from a previous structure possibly destroyed in the great Savannah fire of 1820. Original wood shingles are visible in the attic and wooden pegs and wedges holding beams in place can be found throughout the building.

The best part of 17hundred90 is the long tradition for fine dining and tasty drink. Fresh seafood, carefully prepared steaks, lamb and chicken and southern vegetables combine with fine wines and carefully mixed cocktails to make a delightful dining experience.

Local 11ten

1110 Bull St, Savannah, GA 31401

Situated a block south of Savannah's Forsyth Park in Historic Downtown Savannah, Local 11ten creates a nightly dining experience complete with intelligent cuisine, a welcoming personality and modern design. The restored 1950's-era downtown bank houses a casual, elegant restaurant devoted to popular southern flavors using local and seasonal ingredients such as fresh seafood caught from Georgia's coast and fresh vegetables and herbs from Savannah's own local farmers.

The restaurant's beautiful marble tables situated off of the bar in the center of the dining room comfortably accommodate four or twelve when combined. A semi-private table seats seven in the vault room, complete with cork walls, chocolate brown velvet curtains and an antique brass chandelier in front of the original, historic Mosler co. bank vault. The in-house gallery coordinator revolves monthly art exhibitions throughout the restaurant, adding to the stylistic elements that pull together the contemporary design.

Local ingredients, simple elegance, and local patrons share in Savannah's uniqueness with one another - the importance of community and outreach is to make a difference - locally.

Private dining is available to enhance the experience beyond your regular dining experience.

River House Seafood

Garibaldi

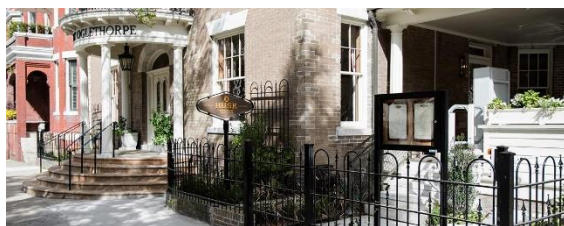
